The Telecommunications United Kingdom Fraud Forum Limited (TUFF) is a Data Controller under the Data Protection Act. We hold information for the purposes of the investigation and prosecution of fraud and crime committed against the telecommunications industry. The information we hold may be used for any of the functions for which the Forum is registered with the Office of The Information Commissioner under Registration Number Z7841484.

We may get information from others or we may give information to them. If we do, it will only be as the law permits, to:

- check accuracy of information
- prevent or detect crime
- Apprehension or prosecution of offenders

We may check information we receive with what is already in our records. This can include information provided by members as well as by others such as other government departments and law enforcement agencies. We will not give information to anyone outside the membership of the Forum unless the law permits us to do so.

Confidentiality and security
